

Dear Parents,

I am writing to you regarding arrangements for the coming school year. Covid continues to be a part of our lives and schools are no different. Arrangements put in place last year will therefore continue for the foreseeable future. The school community kept Covid at bay last year and we ask for your continued cooperation to maintain this.

Arrival to School

All pupils should arrive between **8.30 - 8.40 am** and proceed directly to their classrooms. Parents of pupils in the Infant classroom may accompany their child to the classroom door. Parents of pupils in other classrooms should drop off their child at either gate and leave promptly.

Leaving School

11.45 am Junior Infants will leave at this time up to and including 17th September. Parents should stand outside the classroom in the yard from 11.40 to collect their children. Creches and childminders should be notified of this arrangement.

1.10 pm Senior Infants

2.05 pm 3rd & 4th class

2.00 pm 1st & 2nd class

2.10 pm 5th & 6th class

Parents should arrive no more than 5 minutes before dismissal and leave promptly.

Parking

Parking is available on Church grounds by kind permission of the Select Vestry. There is a one-way system in operation. We ask that you do not spend longer than is necessary on Church grounds. Please inform minders/creches of this arrangement.

Absence from school

Should your child display any symptoms of Covid ([see here](#)), please keep your child at home and contact your GP. If your child/household is identified as a close contact, please follow HSE guidelines. In the event of any absence, whether Covid related or not, please email your class teacher directly.
